## **A New Team for Peckham**

The **Peckham Town Centre Team (TCT)** was launched at the beginning of August with a clear mission: To reduce crime and antisocial behaviour in the town centre area. Since then, officers have been working proactively to tackle persistent problems, achieving real and measurable results for the community.

### **Key Outcomes to Date**

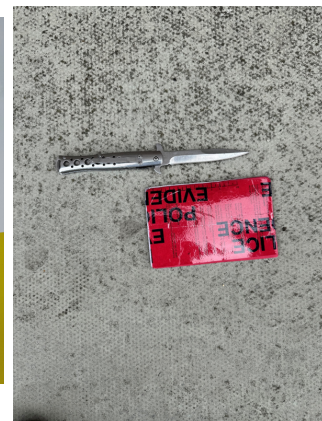
- **Arrests**  
35 arrests have been made in the first few weeks, including the detention of several high risk outstanding suspects.
- **Weapons Removed**  
4 knives and 1 knuckle duster have been seized (pictures below), helping to reduce the risk of serious violence in Peckham.
- **Anti-Social Behaviour**  
Officers have successfully reduced groups congregating at **Peckham Pulse**, a known hotspot for disorder resulting in reclaiming the space for the local community and businesses to live and operate in a safe environment. We have used tactics that will allow us to make a lasting difference to the ASB in the area.

### **Working Together for Peckham**

The TCT is committed to maintaining visible policing, tackling crime, and making Peckham a safer place for everyone. Officers will continue engaging with local residents, businesses, and partners to ensure long term improvements across the town centre. ### **Incidents of Note**

- **Registered Sex Offender**  
A registered sex offender was identified, arrested, and returned to prison, ensuring continued safeguarding for local residents and working towards the Mets priority to make the streets safer for women and girls.
- **Robbery Arrest**  
Officers quickly detained a robbery suspect moments after an offence committed while riding an e-bike. The victims property was recovered and returned.
