

An Anti-Social Behaviour warning has been issued to an individual following reports of persistent nuisance behaviour within a communal flat. This included excessive noise, abusive language, and harassment towards neighbours.

As a result, conditions are now in place for a period of 12 months to prevent further disruption and protect those living in the vicinity.



Officers executed a Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant at a residential address, resulting in the arrest of a male, who has now been charged with handling stolen goods after suspected stolen items were found inside the property.

During the search, officers also recovered several weapons from the living room, including knives and adapted offensive weapons, raising significant safety concerns.

This positive result highlights ongoing efforts to tackle drug-related criminality and remove dangerous items from our communities.



A male was arrested on 26/02/26 at approximately 0530 hours on Sandycombe Road, Kew, after being linked to multiple offences including criminal damage to a dwelling, two Section 4 Public Order offences, criminal damage to a vehicle, and attempts to open several car door handles.

When confronted by a member of the public he threw an item through a house window, and upon police arrival he racially abused a police constable, leading to his further arrest and subsequent charges.



A male was arrested on 20/02/2026 following a shoplifting incident at Tesco, during which he became violent towards staff, assaulting a member of staff and causing ABH, and he was subsequently charged in connection with both the theft and the assault.

North Richmond

LOCAL POLICE, LOCAL KNOWLEDGE

North Richmond officers assisted the East Sheen team in executing a Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant at a residential address, supporting the entry, arrest, search of the premises, and booking-in of the suspect at custody. A male was arrested and later charged with handling stolen goods after suspected stolen items were found inside the property. Officers also recovered several weapons, including knives and adapted offensive weapons, raising significant safety concerns. This positive result highlights strong joint working between teams to tackle drug-related crime and remove dangerous items from the community.



Officers responded to a report of a missing 13-year-old. Using information gathered at the scene and from local enquiries, police were able to quickly locate the child and safely return him to his family home. A debrief was carried out with the child, and an appropriate safeguarding report was completed. Officers also took time to speak with the young person to offer guidance and support aimed at preventing similar situations in the future.
