TARNER PARK

- A focus of ours is and continues to be Turner Park, as we have seen an increase in drug dealing and use in that area. We have encouraged reporting and have upped our patrols in this area. It has been highlighted as an area of interest across the sections in our Neighbourhood Policing Team, so it is covered more frequently.

TYSON PLACE

- We are still working on the continuing drug activity at Tyson Place. A letter drop was done at the start of April this year, there were several responses to this. They all concluded that issues were stemming from two specific addresses in Tyson Place. The feedback has given us a better understanding of the impact it is having on the community. We are currently working with the council and other services to establish the most appropriate steps to tackle these issues.

COURTNEY KING HOUSE

- We have had reports of anti-social behaviour from an unknown male in the car park of these flats. The problems occur usually after 11pm at night, which is difficult as our Neighbourhood Policing Teams finish at 11pm. The issues have

been made aware across all the teams at Brighton to pay attention to the area in those timeframes.

ENGAGEMENT

- We are open to getting involved with any engagement event we can if resourcing and commitments allow. An upcoming event we have is a visit to Royal Spa Nursery to engage with the younger children, this was well received last year.

Key Priorities

- 1- To disrupt the drug activity and highlight the offenders
- 2- To continue to provide the public with reassurance and patrols.
