Currently some key concerns in the area include:

- Drug related behaviour on Cumberland Road, Clermont terrace, Lauriston Road, Clermont Road and Harrington Road.
- Anti-social behaviour in and around St Johns church and Vicarage green.
- Issues relating to youths hanging around outside Dorothy Stringer school.
- Issues on the buses outside Varndean college on Surrenden Road.
- Drug dealing by the Rotunda Café at Preston Park.
- Speeding in Preston drove.

In response to this, I will be engaging within the community in Preston Park as well as increasing foot patrols to help with the ongoing issues. I will engage with the local schools and councillors to gain a bigger picture of what is going on and how best to address these issues.
