Current Ward Priorities

Anti-social behaviour & drug-related activity – Regular patrols continue in known hotspots. There has been an increase in drug taking activities in and around Upper Lewes Road. We have received reports for Stanley Road, Beaconsfield Road, Viaduct Road, Ditchling Rise, Winchester Street and Clyde Road. We are monitoring this and trying to increase our patrols in these areas.
