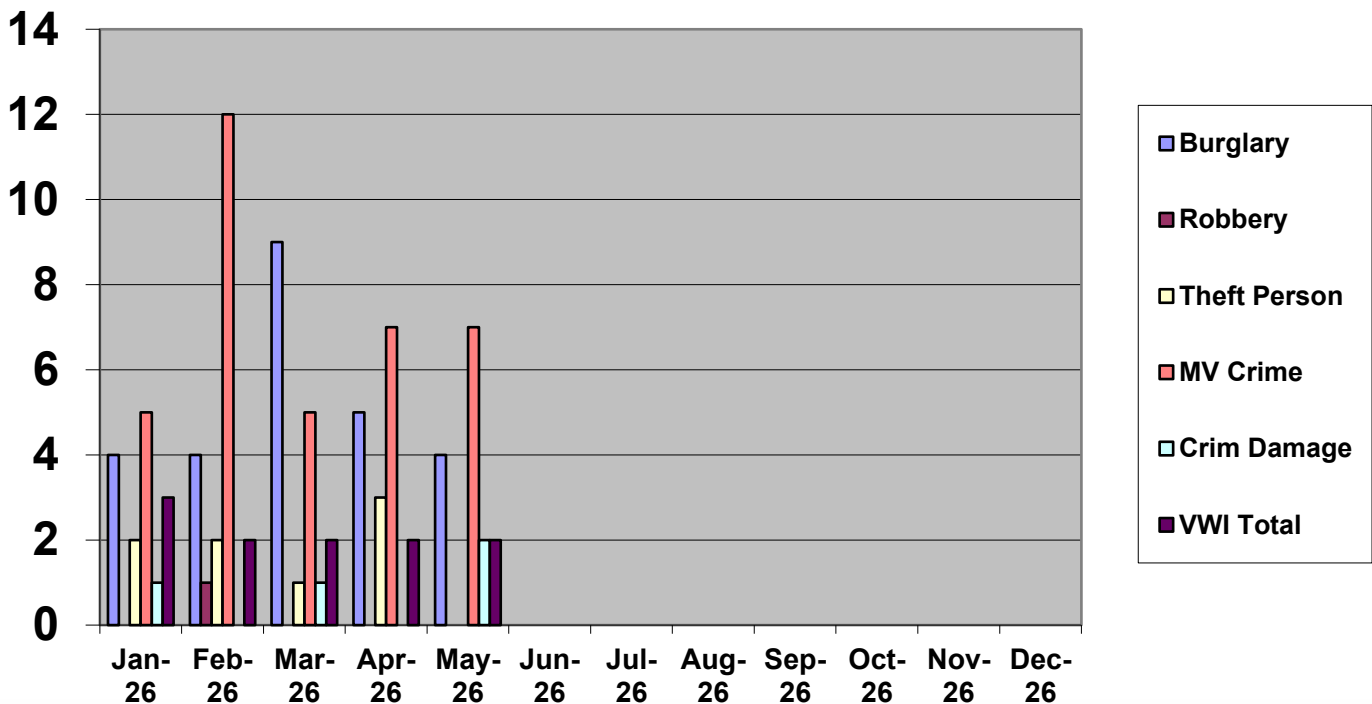
If you are going away on holiday, please ensure your homes are secure and doors and windows are locked, alarms are set and CCTV is working.
