- Speeding (321 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)) checks between 01/12/2024 and 31/12/2024.
 - One visit to Newton Harcourt, and four visits to A47, and one visit to A6 in Kibworth. For more information, visit the police website.
- Anti social behaviour (208 votes on NHL) identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (134 votes on NHL) We have been conducting uniformed and
 marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed
 officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing
 problems in these areas.

A day in the life of a beat officer.

Last night the neighbourhood team paired up with our proactive team to look to arrest persons who had failed to answer their court cases If you fail to attend court after being charged with an offence the magistrate or judge can issue a warrant for your arrest Then the police are tasked with finding you and getting you to the next available sitting Last night we achieved 23 persons arrested for warrants or prison recalls 21 arrested for matters we wanted to speak to them about (assault, damage and harassment) 2 added bonus a person we had circulated was arrested by our Cheshire Police colleagues and our night shift were leaving to bring them back to Leics for the morning CID as we left . #yousaidwedid #inyourcommunity.
