You said - We did

- Speeding (107 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)) . Between 01/07/2026 and 31/07/2026 the mobile speed camera visited the A47 six times, A6003 once, and B6047 five times. In total thirty one offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour on the roads (52 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing anti social behaviour on e-bikes and e-scooters, passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Drug dealing (36 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting plain clothes patrols in areas we are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and Crimestoppers and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through Crimestoppers.

This month, officers spotted a man who was wanted for shoplifting and burglary. Jamie Dobson (36 of Leicester) was arrested and charged with burglary to a store in Houghton on the Hill. Officers then spotted a male wanted in relation to shop thefts. He was arrested and taken to custody. Christopher Chapman (38 of Leicester) was interviewed and charged with a theft was from Co-op in Scraptoft. He is now awaiting a date in court where we will apply for a Criminal Behaviour Order to prevent him targeting the store. This is some great teamwork between all our policing areas and shifts for securing these results for those stores targeted. It is also a reminder to continue to report matters to us so we can tackle those who cause the most harm in our community.
