

You said - We did

- Speeding (34 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)) between 01/02/2025 and 28/02/2025, 3 mobile speed checks along the A47, 19 offences. 2 visits to A6 at Kibworth, 8 offences. 1 visit to Glen Road, Newton Harcourt. 5 offences.
- Anti social behaviour (21 votes on NHL) identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Nuisance motorbikes (19 votes on NHL) We have been conducting uniformed and marked vehicle patrols in the areas you have told us this is a problem. We have directed officers to these areas in any down time they have to deter these offenders from causing problems in these areas.

Harborough police recently invited parish councillors to Police HQ to meet with the local policing team and partners to talk through the issues that were important to them.

Presentations were given by partner agencies, and Inspector Liz Perry, who talked about policing priorities and crime in the district. Inspector Perry said: "It was a great opportunity for parish councillors, who are all volunteers in their community, to meet their local neighbourhood officers and other policing units like the Road Safety Unit to discuss how we can work together on the issues that really matter to the community".



Recently, officers from the Harborough North team have been out using a new piece of equipment available to neighbourhood officers called Trucam 2 which essentially is a speed gun which allows us to measure drivers speed and record footage 2. This allows us to send a notice of intended prosecution out in the post rather than having to physically stop every car found speeding.

Its much faster and easier with irrefutable evidence which we will be utilizing going forward.
