## What matters to you

From data collated from local surveys, beat knowledge, intelligence and reports made to Leicestershire Police, the following have been highlighted as priorities within the community.

### Priority 1: Drugs.

**You said:** Drug use and supply is ongoing in the Saffron Lane Estate and in other areas of the community.

**We did:** A caution was issued to an individual who was found to be in possession of drugs, officers were able to stop them after they were sighted riding an illegal off-road bike, after a small foot chase the individual was stopped and search with the bike also being seized.

### Priority 2: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) in open spaces.

**You said:** ASB in open spaces is still occurring in parks, play areas and other areas.

**We did:** Patrols in open spaces across the beat have been conducted by the local team, after the recent half term break there have been no reports of continued and persistent issues in these locations. These patrols will continue as it gets lighter out with the aim of tackling issues at the earliest opportunity.

### Priority 3: Vehicle Crime.

**You said:** That vehicle crime has increased in the community.

**We did:** Much the same as last month vehicle related crime has continued to decrease significantly across the beat, despite this the local team will still be conducting visible patrols, and I would advise that everyone follows crime prevention advice when it comes your motorbikes, car and vans using the information below.

## Other Local News

The Clear, Hold, Build, initiative (CHB) which launched in the Saffron Lane Estate in 2024 known locally as the Safer Saffron campaign has recently been reviewed and has gained some significantly positive results.

The aim of the government lead initiative that works in tandem with both the police and the local council was launched to tackle issues such as drug use/supply, violent crime, reduce ASB and weapon possession all aimed at making the Saffron Lane Estate a nicer and safer place to live and work.

Overall crime in this area has been reduced by 14.2%, there have been several county lines groups shut down as well as closure orders at addresses associated with drugs and ASB related offences. Large amounts of Class A drugs and cash have been seized as well as offensive weapons and 16 search warrants executed during the clear phase.
