You Said	We did
General ASB, congregating youths e-scooters and bikes.	A report was received about John Court stating there were youths in the precinct with balaclavas. Unfortunately that on its own is not an offence, unless they were being anti-social. The caller hung up on our call taker as they were taking further details.
Burglaries both residential and commercial.	Residential burglary reported in Grange Drive, Whetstone. This was a Car key burglary where their vehicle was stolen. The car was found and recovered, CCTV enquiries ongoing. This is currently under investigation by CID.
Road Safety including car cruising, anti-social driving and vehicle safety has been highlighted by the public as an issue.	Officers conducted an 'Operation Pedal Fast' at Blaby precinct and the surrounding area, this was due to reports of ASB riders. No bikes seized on this occasion, believed to be because of terrible weather conditions.

## News

Blaby Beat Officers have seized more vehicles in Glen Parva and Blaby relating to traffic offences. The white golf below was linked to two 'failed to stop' for PC Bond and used in crime. Officers found it parked up in the street.



The silver Clio was recovered for no tax, and a further vehicle was recovered in Blaby for parking on double yellows, a dropped curb and in front of a garage displaying a 'no parking' sign!

Two of our wonderful Response Officers attended reports of anti-social behaviour at Victory Park in Cosby. A group of youths were located and spoken to, with parents arriving to collect some of those involved. Words of advice were given prior to them leaving.

Officers were called by a resident after hours to a local Newsagents in Blaby last month, after persons entered the property and a number of items were stolen. CID are now dealing with this investigation which occurred at Twins Newsagents on the 4th February between 01:45 and 02:30 hours. Unfortunately we've had a few 'car key burglaries' on our beat, one on Grange Drive, Glen Parva where the keys to their car were taken and subsequently their vehicle. The car was later discovered the following day on the Eyres Monsell estate. Another one was on the Little Glen Road, Glen Parva in the early hours of the morning, but fortunately they were disturbed by a neighbour; and finally another car key break at Saville Road, in Blaby where although the occupants were at home the intruders still managed to enter the property and take the vehicle, the vehicle was subsequently located a few hours later in Braunstone Town.

Remember to lock your vehicle and do not leave your keys on display, find a safe place to keep your keys, away from your front and rear doors. If you see anything suspicious call 999 immediately.
