

- Anti social behaviour identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity, particularly around half term, Halloween and bonfire night, which historically sees a rise in ASB.
- Vehicle crime increasing awareness of theft of workers tools from workers vans. Preventing theft of motor bikes by providing handlebar locks. And reassuring victims of theft of number plates from their cars by providing free number plate screws to prevent removal.
