Violence related -

There as been high violence related crimes within Selsdon Vale and Forestdale area. To combat the rise of sudden violence, we are planning on having high visibility patrols in the known areas of violence in the ward, to deter violent crimes from happening.

Theft from motor vehicle -

In the recent months there has been high theft from motor vehicles relating to catalytic converter thefts from cars in the local area and neighbouring wards. To combat the rise of thefts, we will actively patrol roads on the ward, that are being repeat victims of this crime.

Burglary -

There has been an increase of burglaries happening in the local area of late. To combat these crimes, we will attend every victim of burglary and provide reassurance advice. We will also commence high visibility patrols of hotspot locations. Although this month, burglary has decreased over the past couple of months. Seen on crime maps.

OTHER NEWS

In the month of march, SNT officers have been receiving numerous reports around Forestdale regarding ASB from youths smoking cannabis in the communal areas of the flats. To combat this increase of ASB, SNT officers has made their primary goal to increase visual targeted patrols around Forestdale flats via WOODPECKER MOUNT, FRIARS WOOD, PENNYCROFT and MID-DLEFIELDS and others. As well as conducting targeted patrols, we have also posted ASB letters on windows inside the communal areas, in attempts to deter youths from committing ongoing ASB.
