Updates for Brixworth



Officers have had a busy few months across Brixworth. School visits have been carried out at Harlestone Primary School, Buckton Fields Primary School and Daffodils Nursery in Arthingworth. Regular police surgeries are held at Brixworth and Moulton Community Centre, and the team also attended the Brixworth summer fair.

Speed enforcement activity was carried out in June in Maidwell, Great Oxendon and Sywell Road in Overstone:

- Maidwell- Two warnings were issued to drivers travelling at 33mph and 34mph in a 30mph zone.
- Great Oxendon- One fixed penalty notice was issued to a driver travelling at 56mph in a 40mph zone.
- Sywell Road, Overstone- One fixed penalty notice was issued to a driver travelling at 56mph in a 40mph zone. Two further vehicles were given warnings for travelling at 33mph in a 30mph zone.

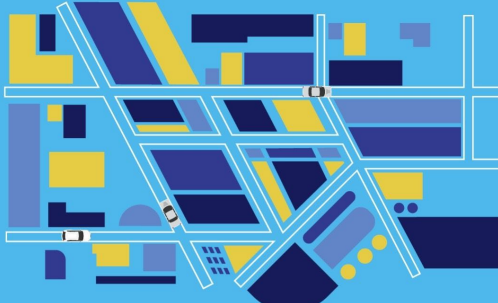

Tackling e-scooters

Officers from the Daventry Neighbourhood Policing Team and the Force's Anti-Social Behaviour Team worked alongside colleagues from West Northamptonshire Council, Northamptonshire Fire and Rescue Service, and the Daventry Town Ranger team for a day of engagement in the town centre. During the operation, officers also engaged with three people using e-scooters.
