Queen's Park Ward Update

From your local PCSOs

Neighbour Disputes

We are currently seeing a high volume of neighbour disputes in the Queen's Park area, both long-standing and newly emerging cases.

If you're experiencing issues with a neighbour, your first point of contact should always be your housing provider or landlord. They hold significant responsibility for managing behaviour within their properties and often have the authority to take direct action.

However, if a situation involves threatening behaviour, violence, or public order offences, this should be reported to the police immediately.

As PCSOs, we can assist by:

- Offering mediation support where appropriate

- Delivering words of advice to those involved
- Increasing visible patrols in areas where issues persist

Please don't hesitate to reach out — early intervention can often prevent a situation from escalating.

Tyson Place

In our previous update, we mentioned ongoing work with the council to address concerns around Tyson Place. Following a period of reduced reports, we have recently seen another spike in complaints.

In response, we will be increasing patrols in and around the building, especially as the Brighton Youth Centre is set to reopen this September. We are working closely with partners to manage this effectively and continue to look for long-term solutions.

Upcoming patrols
