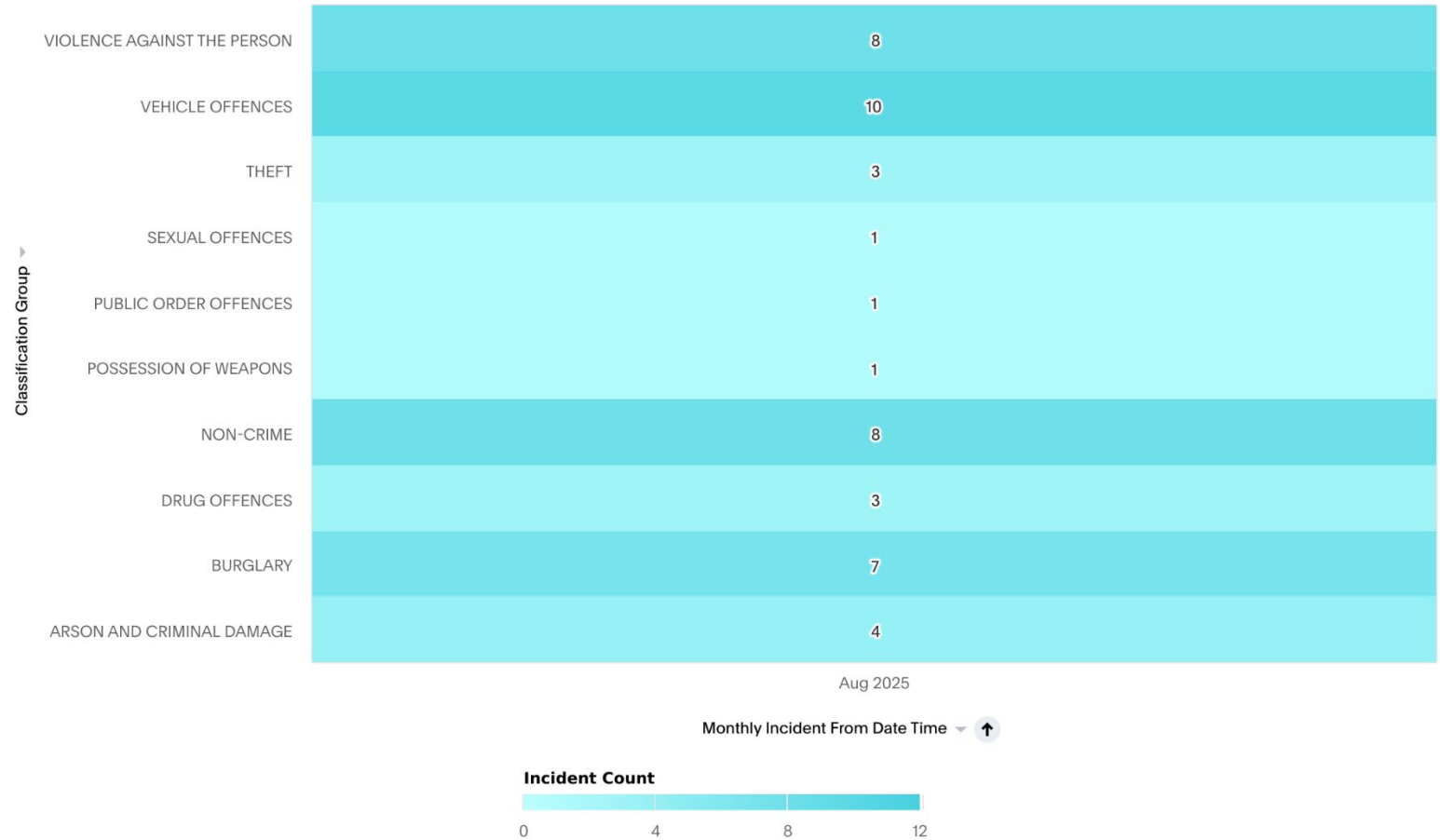

## Burglary/Attempted burglary

### Attempted Residential Burglary:

**Chimes Avenue** – attempted burglary of a dwelling. Offence happened on 03/08/2025. Entry and exit gained via the garden side gate. Nothing stolen as suspects were disturbed.

### Attempted Non-Residential:

**Cambridge Upholstery, Cheapside** – on 12/08/2025 suspects unknown attempted to break through the shutter lock of the venue. Suspects were unable to do so.

### Burglary Residential:

**Crawford Gardens** – between 03/08/2025 around 18:00hrs and 04/08/2025 around 17:45hrs the premises has been entered by unknown suspects while the owner of the house was away on holiday.

**Mintern Close** – On 13<sup>th</sup> August the premises has been broken into with the front door of a first-floor flat being smashed open. Untidy search had been conducted with items stolen.

**Hedge Lane** – On 24<sup>th</sup> August victim has awoken to unknown male in her bedroom who has taken a box of jewellery and climbed out of the bathroom window.

**Ash Grove** – On 24<sup>th</sup> August victim has returned from holiday to find his front door has been forced open and untidy search of the premises.

**Barrowell Green** – residential burglary happened on 23<sup>rd</sup> August while victims were away. The victim has noticed that the back gate was open and believed that this was the point of entry. They noticed that the back sliding door had been smashed, and untidy search had been completed. The only room disturbed was a master bedroom.

## Theft:

**Barrowell Green** - Employed cleaner has been witnessed on CCTV stealing items from victims private dwelling. Taken Perfume bottles from bedroom.

**Hedge Lane** – resident stolen others game console.

## Motor vehicle offences:

**The Larches** – On 3<sup>rd</sup> August between 00:01hrs and 04:00hrs unknown suspect(s) gained entry to the vehicle parked on The Larches. Wallet, bank cards, chargers and wires had been stolen. No damage to the car.

**Harington Terrace** – On 3<sup>rd</sup> August at approximately 22:00hrs victim noticed someone taking stuff from their car. Informant reported that then the suspect walked down and opened other people cars and has taken stuff.

**Connaught Gardens** – On 5<sup>th</sup> August hired vehicle was broken into. It's possible the car was left unlocked. Bag with car and house keys and wallet with bank cards had been taken.

**The Fairway** – On 9<sup>th</sup> August driving licence and bank cards had been stolen from the vehicle. No damage to the car.

**Chimes Avenue** – On 12 August unknown suspect broke into the vehicle and stole loose coins from within. Suspect gained access via the boot as the boot was left unlocked.

**Highfield Road** – On 12 August at approximately 05:18hrs unknown suspect attempted to open the victim's car door and boot before moving on down the street.

**Farm Road** – On 12 August unknown suspect attempted to enter vehicle parked on driveway. Disturbed by security alarm run away.

**Mintern Close** – Between 12/08/25 22:00hrs to 13/08/25 07:15hrs victim's van had been accessed. No damage was caused.

**Hazelwood Lane** – On 20th August unknown suspect entered the victim's vehicle, rummaged through it, but nothing was stolen. The victim was uncertain whether the vehicle was locked.

**The Larches** – On 24th August radio and parts of dashboard had been stolen from inside parked vehicle.

**New Park Avenue** – On 27th August vehicle had been swapped on Facebook for a stolen vehicle.

## Criminal damage:

**Cosgrove Close** – criminal damage to victim's door.

North Circular Road – criminal damage to a vehicle.

**The Larches** – padlock had been removed/broken from private gate.

**Crawford Gardens** – informant reported someone banging on their door for few nights and there were eggs thrown at their door.

## Drugs:

**Cosgrove Close** – male found with cannabis during stop and search.

**Barrow Close** – possession of cannabis.

**New Park Avenue** - Cloned vehicle stopped in NA borough, cannabis found in the car which suspect admitted to its possession.

**Metropolitan Police warrant cards and passes are changing**

If you have any contact with police officers or staff from the Metropolitan Police Service their identity document will look different. There is nothing you need to do, other than familiarise yourself with the new document.
