What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and prioritised the following:

Priority 1: Theft offences

You said: Shoplifting and theft from motor vehicles offences were a problem across the beat

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols at key locations, working with shops and partnership agencies to reduce thefts.

Priority 2: Drug issues specifically at Castle Gardens

You Said: Drug dealing and related anti-social behaviour is an issue on the beat we want to tackle this.

What we are going to do: Targeted patrols to develop intelligence and utilise Police powers to deal with those causing the issues.

Priority 3: Cycle thefts specifically at De Montfort University

You said: Theft of cycles are an issue on the beat, especially across the university campus.

What we are going to do: Partnership working with De Montfort University and the dedicated Officer to patrol bike shelters, provide crime safety advice, bike register events and continue to investigate theft crimes.

What we have done #yousaidwewdid

- Officers have continued to patrol hot spot areas, including the NCP car park and open park spaces and other
 areas that attract anti-social behaviour and rough sleeping. Working with relevant agencies to get those who
 need it support.
- Continue to visit those members of the community and businesses that have reported anti-social behaviour and worked with our partnership agencies to help tackle these issues.
- Assisted with several operations across the beat and city centre, including OP GIZMO—tackling county line and drugs and OP Ramadan.
- Continued to support "Project Search" by providing safety awareness which helps young adults into employment
- Developing intelligence on the beat and successfully located cannabis grows which have been dismantled, made safe and investigations ongoing.
