After recent work with members of the Public, local officers have managed to identify a male riding a Quadbike recklessly on a footpath through the Stanhope area in Ashford.

As this male has now been identified through CCTV enquiries and local reporting by the public, this male has been reported for several driving offences, as well as being served with a Community Protection Notice, prohibiting him from using specific vehicles for a lengthy period of time.
