How not to become a victim of vehicle crime !

Do - Lock your vehicle every time you leave it, close all windows (including the sun roof) and set the alarm etc.

Don't - Leave keys in the ignition/engine running if you are not with your vehicle (thieves like places where people make short stops ie newsagents).

Do - Remove portable Sat Navs (including the cradle or suction pad) and the fascia from your vehicle stereo and take them with you.

Don't - Leave bags, mobile phones, money or other valuables on display. Laptops should be removed or, if not possible, be either shut down or have the Bluetooth device turned off.

Do - Remove disabled parking permits when the permit is not in use.

Don't - Leave tools and work equipment in vehicles overnight.

Do - Replace the fixings on your number plates with non-returnable 'clutch head' screws (available in good DIY stores etc).
