Kidbrooke Village & Sutcliffe Ward

In June, SNT officers conducted reassurance patrols to targeted areas near Aldi after two teenagers were victims of aggravated robbery at knife point.

Officers attending the call located the suspects promptly and arrested the males retrieving the knives. If you have further information regarding this incident, please contact 101. Your SNT will continue to patrol the area reassuring the local youth and businesses.

The team carried out a stop and search for Cannabis in Sutcliffe Park and continue to patrol the park proactively tackling the issue of drug use in public spaces on the ward. SNT has been in regular contact with Greenwich Council to discuss joint interventions on issues raised by residents, including anti-social noise and behaviour; officers are committed to continuing to cultivate these partnerships.

SNT Officers in collaboration with the MET LGBT+ Community Liaison Officer will provide advice and information from our stand at the event, don't hesitate to come and meet the Team.

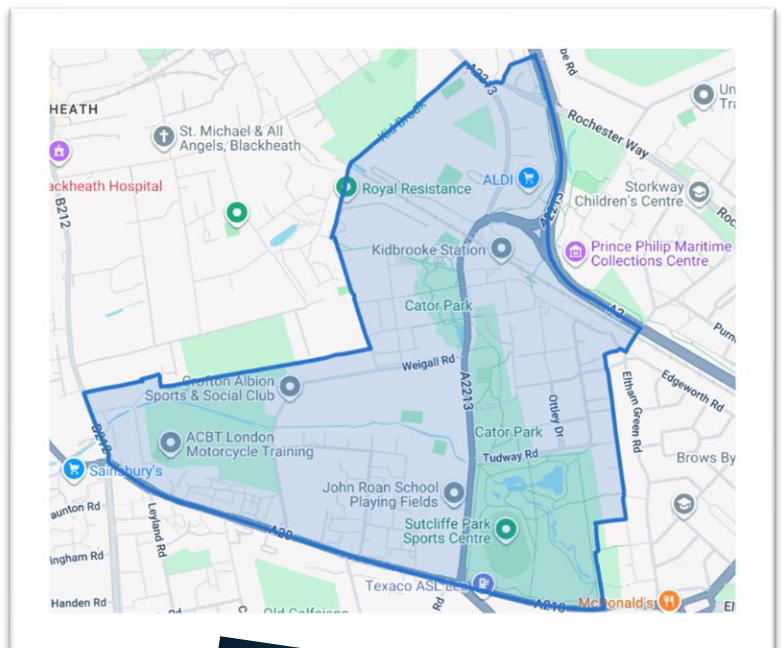
This is an opportunity for the local community to meet the SNT Team and talk about any issues.
