## What matters to you

We have listened to you and the concerns you raised and will priorities the following from March 2025.

**Priority 1: ASB. You said**: You have concerns around antisocial behavior across the village. We will continue to try and disrupt this type of behavior and use the ASB incremental approach to deter offenders.

**Priority 2: Speeding. You said:** You are concerned about vehicles speeding in the villages. We will continue to monitor and enforce speed across several sites in the village.

**Priority 3: Burglaries.** We aim to work with the relevant authorities to reduce the burglaries across the village and to try and reduce the number of reported thefts from the recycling centre. Visiting victims and offering crime prevention advice.

#### **November**

#### Priority 1: The beat team aim to tackle different elements of ASB in Mountsorrel

In the October Newsletter I made reference to some ASB that was reported in the village over the October half term. Further to the banning letters that were initially issued, all perpetrators but one have now been spoken to with parents/guardians present. Furthermore we are exploring an alternative disposal for the youngsters with a collaborative approach with other agencies.

We have also completed high visibility patrols in the main hotspots and have seen no issues.

#### Priority 2: The beat team aim to target reports of speeding in Mountsorrel.

#### **Speed Ops**

We have completed covert speed checks on Leicester Road. Out of 144 cars that passed in the thirty minute period around forty were travelling over the speed limit. The vast majority between 31-35mph.

#### **Priority 3: Burglaries**

There has been no reported burglaries for the last fourteen days. The patrols throughout the day and night continue.
