## Nunhead & Queen's Road

### What we've been doing this month:

Nunhead and Queen's Road SNT have been taking the opportunity to do community engagement this month. We have visited the Smart Kids Nursery on Culmore Road. This was a lovely visit, where we had the young kids try on police hats and helmets, and ask questions about our jobs. We also did this with the Camberwell Beavers, where they also got to have a look at our police cars and use the lights and sirens.

Officers also helped at the St Thomas Apostle College open day for new Sixth Formers.

All of these visits went very well and hope to do them all again soon!

Our officers have also been busy with 2 arrests for Possession with Intent to Supply drugs and 10 stop and searches. They have attended an eviction and aided in a vehicle operation, where seizures and traffic reports took place. Proactive patrols were conducted specifically for phone snatches too!

CPWs and CPNs are still being given out to those causing ASB, shoplifting and taking drugs. This has seen a real positive effect for the ward.

Officers continue to work with partner agencies to reduce ASB on the ward.
