What matters to you

We have identified the following priorities which are in place as of 1st April 2026:

- **Priority 1: Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**

You Said: ASB is prevalent in the local area and continues to cause concerns, particularly within the estate.

We Did: As we head into the lighter evenings we will look to increase patrols in hotspot areas. We will look at early intervention with perpetrators and enforcement action against repeat offenders to prevent further disruption to residents. We encourage any residents experiencing issues to report via 101 or online.

- **Priority 2: Drug Dealing**

You Said: Drug dealing continues to be a key issue around the estate.

We Did: Officers have continued to carry out proactive stop searches around the estate. We continue to work closely with Leicester City Council in relation to tenancy enforcement and potential closure orders where evidence thresholds are met. Intelligence development remains ongoing, and we encourage residents to continue providing information confidentially via 101 or Crimestoppers. - **Priority 3: Off-Road Vehicles**

You Said: In previous years as we head towards the summer, off-road bikes and quad bikes start to become an issue – being ridden illegally and dangerously in open and green spaces.

We Did: We will be carrying out dedicated patrols looking at this issue. We have already had reports of bikes being ridden on the green space on GOLDHILL in the last few weeks. After information was received by local residents as to where these bikes may be coming from, local officers have visited these addresses and issued strong advice against future illegal riding. We will continue to monitor and take positive action where possible.

- ◆ Officers have continued to carry out proactive stop checks across the estate. One has resulted in Daniel Frappe, 31, being charged with two counts of possession of an offensive weapon in a public place, acquiring/using/possessing criminal property, possession of a firearm length less than 30cm/60cm - prohibited weapon, possession of ammunition for a firearm without a certificate, possession with intent to supply class A drugs namely cocaine and possession with intent to supply class B drugs namely cannabis. The charges relate to a vehicle which was stopped by police in Lawford Road, Leicester on Monday (16 March).
