Dear Resident,

I'm writing to provide an update in relation to an incident which took place at Kingsbury High School in Brent on Wednesday.

Officers were called to Bacon Lane at 12:40, following reports of a stabbing incident. They arrived within 13 minutes of the first 999 call and began their investigation.

This investigation has progressed at pace, and we can let you know that a suspect has been arrested on suspicion of attempted murder and remains in custody. The two children who were injured are both still in hospital, but their injuries are not life threatening and they are in a stable condition.

I understand that such a horrific incident can have a significant impact on your community, and I want to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to keep you safe.

Over the coming days, you are likely to see more police officers around Kingsbury High school, especially at the start and end of school, as well as by places of worship, and transport links like bus stops and train stations. This is not because of an ongoing threat, but because we know that you will want to feel safe.

The investigation is currently being led by our colleagues in Counter Terrorism Policing; however, the incident is not currently being treated as a terrorist incident. While this investigation is underway, we are limited in what we can and can't say in public, so we do not jeopardise any future court proceedings. However as soon as we can provide updates we will continue to do so.

If you have any concerns or worries, please do not hesitate to approach and speak to our officers. We are here for you and will be happy to listen and address any issues you may have and are committed to both keeping you safe and making you feel safe in your community.
