

Did you know?

- Any vehicle that uses keyless entry is at risk of relay theft.
- Thieves only need to be within a few metres of your vehicle keys to capture the signal.
- It can take less than two minutes for thieves to gain full access to your vehicle.



1. One offender holds a device against the house, amplifying the signal.
2. The second offender stands by the house with a device that relays the key's signal back to their accomplice.
3. The vehicle is fooled into believing the key is close by.
4. The vehicle door opens and the signal is relayed a second time, either starting the engine or enabling the offender to press the starter button.
