### Kidbrooke Village & Sutcliffe Ward

Your Safer Neighbourhood Team targeted patrols around Sutcliffe Park, Pegler Square, Weigall Road and surrounding areas for anti-social behaviour including drug dealing and drug consumption, shoplifting and VAWG. This is still an ongoing issue that we take very seriously, and we will continue to target over the coming weeks by undertaking proactive high-visibility and plain clothes patrols.

There have been multiple proactive interventions for shoplifting and ASB in Pegler Square, Ignatius Sancho Road B&M and Aldi with warnings issued.

Officers have assisted with interviews, wanted offenders' arrests and mental health warrants. Officers arrested one male and conducted five stop and searches with positive outcomes.

On Op Zoridan, officers deployed around Greenwich over the three days and managed to visit 52 venues with partners from Local Authority, Licensing and Apple.

10 arrests made for drugs, handling, wanted offenders and officers seized a large amount of drugs, property and countless mobile phones.

The Ward Panel was held on the 20/11/2025 at The Kidbrooke Community Centre and members had the opportunity to talk about the emerging issues on the ward.

The third quarter crime statistics were presented and discussed. A copy of these can be found attached to this Newsletter for your awareness. Emerging issues raised in the meeting directly to local officers were.

\* ASB at Pegler Square, Ignatius Sancho Road B&M and Aldi.

\* Rise of parcel theft on multiple locations on the ward.

The new ward priorities are.

- 1- Parcel theft
- 2- Residential burglary
- 3- Anti social behaviour

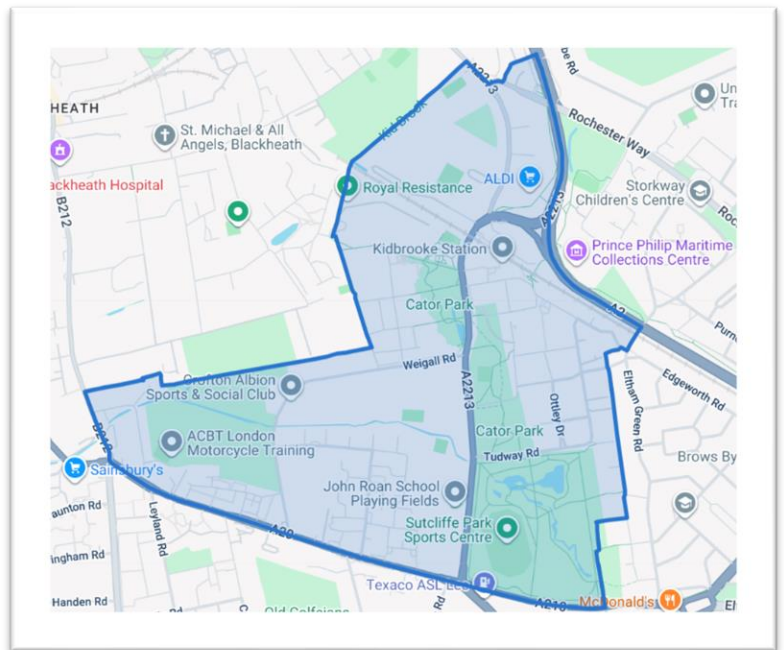
