Nuisance Motorbikes

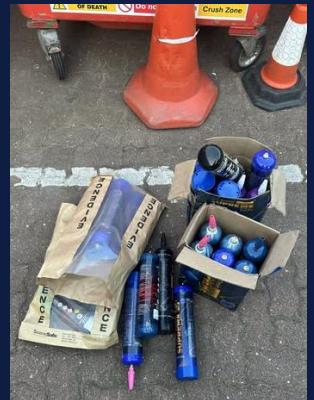
In May, Nuneaton South SNT Officers were in the Hilltop area of Nuneaton when a motorbike went past the officers on one wheel. The rider was stopped and after a struggle, the male was searched to find a large zombie knife and a bag of cannabis. The male was arrested and charged with possession of a bladed article, possession of cannabis, driving with no insurance, driving without a licence and driving with no helmet. Another male who obstructed police during the incident will be spoken to at a later date. Please continue to report nuisance motorbikes – ‘Operation Undertook’ is the dedicated operation dealing with nuisance bikes.

Crimes Discovered in Bedworth Parks

Whilst patrolling Bedworth's parks looking for offenders using Nitrous Oxide, PC Alison Rudkin and PC Benjamin Pedley located a male consuming the drug. He was 'High' from the drugs, but this quickly turned into a low when the resulting criminal record was explained. Numerous other canisters were located hidden, so they were emptied and seized. In another park, officers stopped and searched a male and his vehicle, acting on some intelligence given by a member of the public. A large amount of suspected counterfeit cigarettes were located and seized. Trading Standards have been notified and once confirmed action will be taken against the male and his business.



Parking Issues at Bedworth Schools

Following continuous issues with inconsiderate parking, officers from Bedworth SNT have attended Bedworth schools, including: Race Leys Junior School, St Michael's Primary School and Exhall Cedars Infant & Nursery School. Our visible presence during pick up times has helped remind drivers not to park on the yellow zig zags outside the schools and prevent dangerous parking. During these patrols, a number of Traffic Offence Reports (TORs) have been issued and submitted to the Traffic Processing Unit. Thank you to those who are parking responsibly and helping to keep our school communities safe.

Water Safety advice

In very hot weather it can be tempting to jump in and swim in areas of open water like Ensors Pool, but please remember it comes with many dangers. Even when outdoor temperatures are high, water can still be extremely cold and cause shock, which can quickly lead to drowning. There are also hidden dangers beneath the surface including sudden drops, poor visibility and discarded objects that can trap or injure swimmers. Please enjoy the nice weather but stay safe and don't swim in open water unless it's a designated and supervised swimming area.



Illegal Electric Bikes


Officers recently stopped a 17-year-old rider on a heavily modified pushbike that had been converted into an illegal e-bike. When tested, the bike was capable of reaching speeds of approximately 55mph with the rear wheel lifted, and it had been altered to remove the pedals entirely, replacing them with foot rests. Bikes of this type are not road legal and pose a significant risk to both the rider and other road users. If found illegal e-bikes, for example without pedals, will be seized.
