While PCSOs Broughton-Rates and Smyth aided Nunhead and Queens Road ward with a Senior Citizens Seasonal Safety Talk, a Christmas Meeting at Bells Gardens where they introduced MetEngage to residents and the regular patrols of ward priorities; PC Salter made an arrest, issued ASB warnings, a CPW and conducted a s.23 MDA stop and search which led to the issuing of a PND.

After a vast amount of behind the scenes planning; Friday 12th December saw a Day of Action on Peckham Square and the surrounding areas rolled out with the assistance of numerous SNTs (from across the borough), PC Neil Baker, PCSOs Broughton-Rates and Amponsah guided two large teams across the day which resulted in; 2 arrests, 1X Moped – No Insurance, 3X eBikes – No Insurance, 1X eScooter and a high number of S1 PACE stop and Search and issuing of Community Protection Warnings, Dispersals and with our Southwark Partners Vulnerable Homeless people rehoused.

Huge thanks to all colleagues and partners who made this possible, many locals said it was great to see us all 'out and about'; they also took the time to go through some of their needs/wishes for January and beyond.

Peckham SNT teamed up with a neighbouring ward again as they assisted Old Kent Road with a successful traffic operation on the border of the two wards. Over thirty e-bikes and e-scooters were seized during the day.

Finally for the festive month of 2025; PC Gilbert is joining Peckham ward from Old Kent Road at the beginning of January. Welcome Heather, we look forward to working with you.
