Untaxed vehicle seizure



Local officers have seized an untaxed vehicle in the Kingsthorpe area as part of ongoing efforts to keep our roads safe and ensure vehicles are being used legally. Untaxed vehicles can have a negative impact on the local community. They are often linked to other vehicle-related offences, may not be properly insured or roadworthy, and can contribute to anti-social behaviour. Untaxed vehicles also place an unfair burden on law-abiding motorists who pay vehicle tax and comply with legal requirements.

Moulton Park vehicle update

Over the last few months, officers have been working in partnership with West Northamptonshire Council on a joint operation targeting abandoned and nuisance vehicles across the Moulton Park estate. We are pleased to report that a total of five vans have now been successfully removed from the estate. While initial online database checks suggested one of the vehicles was fully taxed and had a valid MOT, a physical check of the chassis number revealed a completely different VRM (Vehicle Registration Mark). This vehicle was removed. Our teams will continue to work along the remaining sections of the road to address any further problematic vehicles. Thank you for your continued support in keeping our community safe.

Local officers have successfully recovered a recently stolen motorcycle from the Headlands ward area, and we are pleased to confirm that the owner has been informed. Thank you to everyone for your continued vigilance and for reporting any suspicious activity to help keep our community safe.

Drug warrant executed

Following concerns raised by our local community, officers carried out a Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant at an address on Cranbrook Road, Kingsthorpe on June 14. This action follows problem-solving work, intelligence gathering and investigation by local PCs and PCSOs. The warrant was positive, with a large quantity of cannabis seized.
