Residential Burglary – SIX (6) BURGLARIES and ONE (1) Attempted

Hotspot areas:

- 1. Three (3) parcel thefts and One (1) opportunist walked in through an open front door and stole a passport.

- 2. An attempted burglary as suspect was seen snooping around?
- 3. The residents were on holiday and suspects entered via the side garden window and went upstairs and stole property. No alarm. No CCTV at the time of the burglary.
- 4. The side gate forced open and broken into the shed. No CCTV/Floodlight camera. No witnesses.

What time: 3 x Wednesday & Saturday, 1 x Sunday

Theft from motor vehicle – THREE (3)

Hotspot areas: *North and South of the Ward*

What times? Saturday and Sunday

CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE

- Window smashed and box of goods to be returned stolen. [Keeping vehicles safe | Crime prevention | Metropolitan Police](#)
 - Wind deflector stolen from a motor vehicle by thieves.
 - Parcel shelf stolen. Always remember to take your parcel shelf inside.
 - ✓ **Remember:** Empty car policy – Nothing to see, nothing to take!
 - ✓ Motor vehicle – never leave any property in the car. Take it inside or put it in the boot (covered).
- Remember** to look after your disabled Blue Badges - if not secured in a disabled Badge holder (see image).

- **Theft of motor vehicle – FOUR (4)**
- **Time:** 2 x overnight 1 x evening, **Date:** Saturday, Sunday, Tuesday, Friday
- **CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE**
- 1. ONE (1) Motorcycle stolen when residents on holiday. Communal CCTV not working). Motorcycle, Moped/scooters must Lock, Chain and Cover. Click on the link below for crime prevention advice

- ONE (1) motor vehicle stolen at 2100 hours. No CCTV. No Alarm installed in the motor vehicle.
- TWO (2) motor vehicles stolen overnight and there is CCTV available.
- **Do Faraday bags work for key fobs?**
- **A Faraday bag will protect your keyless entry fob from being hacked and used to start your car without you knowing.** Faraday sleeves protect valuable devices from electronic pickpockets and vehicles from electronic car thieves

- **Remember: Advise to the Wise – “A Tracker installed in the motor vehicle help to locate and recover the vehicle”.**
- How do police track stolen cars?
- When a vehicle is stolen the Tracker device emits a unique Very High Frequency signal. This can be picked by the police **using the Tracker technology installed in their vehicles** to help track stolen vehicles. A tracker was installed in the motor vehicle, and the owners of the car were able to locate & recover. (*Tracker™ Vehicle Tracking Systems Utilise VHF Tracking to Help Locate Your Stolen Vehicle*)

- **Time:** Day & Evening **Date:** Wednesday Hotspot areas: East of the ward.
- **CRIME PREVENTION ADVICE – Remember personal safety**
- TWO (2) Parcel theft.
- ONE (1) Cleaner has not returned the keys, and it could fall into wrong hands
- ONE (1) iPhone stolen from victim.
