What Matters to you?

Evington Ward

- OPERATION GROOVE A targeted policing operation to prevent any increase in ASB or crime in and around surrounding open spaces.
- A series of educational pieces to highlight the importance of road safety, followed by a series of road safety operations to ensure road safety is maintained across the area.
- Patrol the location of Downing Drive and surrounding areas in a bid to drive down ASB, crime and provide reassurance to the community.
- Provide targeted patrols in the area of Harwin Road and surrounding area to protect the vulnerable and ensure confidence from members of the community surrounding ASB and drugs use.

- Patrols and licence checks with local licenced premises to prevent ASB and crime.

What we are doing

PC Darbar and PCSO Madu have been addressing local issues on Evington Ward, as well as providing assistance with urgent incidents. A glimpse of their recent activities include:

Community Engagement: They have been patrolling areas of concern whilst, maintaining high visibility, and actively engaging with community members.

Parking Issue Resolved: PCSO Madu successfully dealt with an abandoned vehicle that was causing parking problems for local residents.

Accident Response: They have responded to a three-vehicle Road Traffic Collision. One vehicle failed to stop, but all vehicles have since been appropriately handled.

Hospital Patrols: PC Darbar has been conducting regular patrols at the General Hospital to address ongoing issues with a particular individual in the area.

Warrant

Acting on valuable intelligence, a drugs warrant was executed at an address on the Rowlatts Hill Estate with assistance from Coleman Ward's PC Wicks. These activities not only disrupt criminal activity but also send a clear message that we will not tolerate drugs in our community.







Further work within Rowlatts Hill estate took place when PC McCahill liaised with the local Housing Officer. They visited various locations throughout the estate, including specific addresses where they engaged with residents about important tenancy issues and addressed concerns regarding anti-social behaviour.
