Action Taken on the Riders of E-Scooters Being used illegally



In January, the Safer Neighbourhood Teams seized 45 escooters and one modified electric pushbike, that were being driven illegally. The e-scooters seized were taken away to be crushed. PC Lily Patterson is shown loading a seized modified electric pushbike into the police van. They also seized two motorbikes, one from a 14-year-old, and a stolen car. On Friday 24 January, officers came across the scene of an accident in Camp Hill where an e-scooter rider had collided with a car. The young male rider was taken to hospital and treated for a dislocated knee and a fractured collarbone. PC Jonny Walker said, "We've spent the last month or more warning riders that using e-scooters is not only illegal on public

roads, but also dangerous".

Please spread the word that, although it is not illegal to buy escooters, **it is illegal to use them on public roads.**

Nuneaton PC Amelia Loveridge from Nuneaton Safer Neighbourhood Team would like to thank everyone who provided information about suspicious activity at the site of a former pub in Church Road Nuneaton.

"As a result of the information provided, we went to check on the site and discovered it was being used to grow cannabis. We seized 400 plants and discovered the living quarters for the people responsible in a linked building". The fire brigade had put a closure order on the building in 2022 due to it being unsafe, as there was a serious safety risk to anyone going into the building. The production, sale and illegal use of cannabis is not a victimless crime. It often involves organised criminal gangs who traffic vulnerable people into the country and force them to grow cannabis. This will not be tolerated in Nuneaton.

PC 2074 Benjamin Pedley and PC 2572 completed foot patrols as part of Operation Resolve in Bedworth Town Centre and Tesco. Officers will continue with foot patrols around the area to help tackle this issue. If you see any Anti-Social Behaviour, please raise this with officers so they can take appropriate action.

Last year, Bedworth West SNT worked with Nuneaton and Bedworth Borough Council, and other partner agencies, to tackle anti-social behaviour in the Keresley End area. Meetings were held with various activities for young people to participate in, such as: talks on the dangerous use of motorbikes/scooters and knife crime and sessions to introduce young people in the area to fishing. Ash Green School also offered 'After school activities' such as hair & Beauty and cooking. A reduction in Anti-Social Behaviour in the area was noted, following police action where criminal offences have taken place.

Fire at Bedworth Tesco SNT NEWS

Following an investigation into a fire at the Tesco supermarket on Mill Street, Bedworth at the end of January, four boys aged between 11 and 13 were arrested on suspicion of arson endangering life.

Two of the boys were from Bedworth, one from Nuneaton, and the other was from Nottingham. They were later released on bail, pending further investigation.

DI Paul Sartoris said, "A significant amount of damage was caused to the supermarket as a result of the fire, and there was a serious risk that someone could have been badly hurt." "When such serious incidents are reported to the police, we will always take robust action to quickly locate and arrest the suspects."
