Entry Routes & Eligibility Criteria

Police Constable Entry Programme (PCEP)

- Starting salary of £42,210 pa

Eligibility

- You must be between 17 and 57 to apply
- Must have GCSE English at grade C / 4 or above (or an equivalent qualification)
- Must have, or be working towards 2 A Levels or another Level 3 qualification

Police Constable Degree Apprenticeship Programme (PCDA)

- Starting salary of £42,210 pa
- You'll gain a 3 year fully funded BSc degree in Policing Practice.

Eligibility

- You must be between 17 and 57 years old to apply
- Must have GCSE English at grade C / 4 or above (or an equivalent qualification)
- Must have 2 A-Levels or equivalent

Detective Constable Entry Programme (DCEP)

- Starting salary of £42,210 pa

Eligibility

- You must be between 18 and 57 years old to apply
- Must have GCSE English at grade C / 4 or above (or an equivalent qualification)
- Must hold a Level 6 Degree

Nationality Criteria for All Pathways

Applicants must hold one of the following: British Citizenship, Indefinite Leave to Enter & Remain or EU members must have ILR or EU Settled Status.

Police Community Support Officer (PCSO)



- Starting salary is £34,808
- Free travel on or off duty on London's buses
- Work 36 hours a week

Eligibility

- You must be 17 or older when applying to be a PCSO
- Must have English GCSE Grade C (or equivalent) For those who do not hold this qualification, a written test will be available.

Police Staff Roles



- Different pay scales and benefits for different roles
- Staff roles including admin, finance, HR, forensics, IT, data analysis, Met CC and many more
- Training is covered

Eligibility

- Suitability will depend largely on the particular role in which you're interested

Special Constable (Volunteer Police Officers)



- Volunteer Police Officers
- Free TFL travel
- Same power, uniform and responsibilities as a regular officer

Eligibility

- Need to complete 200 hours annually which is only 16 hours a month (2 x 8 hour shifts)

Community Based Volunteers



- Reasonable expenses are paid for travel in London, to and from deployments.
- A range of training opportunities on offer including crime prevention training, personal safety and London life savers.

Eligibility

- Must be over 18 and not be a serving police officer or existing member of police staff

Nationality Criteria for PCSO's, Police Staff & Special Constables

Applicants must hold one of the following: British Citizenship, Indefinite Leave to Enter & Remain or EU members must have ILR or EU Settled Status.
