## You said - We did

- Speeding (10 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)). Between 01/04/2026 and 30/04/2026 the mobile speed camera visited Lubbenham Hill once. In total twenty three offences were detected.
- Anti social behaviour (10 votes on NHL) - identifying individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach. Targeting areas of known ASB activity.
- Drug dealing (11 votes on NHL) - We have been conducting plain clothes patrols in areas we are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and CrimeStoppers and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through CrimeStoppers.

This month, local business premises in Roman Way, Church Square, Manor Walk and St Mary's Road, were subject to a number of overnight burglaries, where glass was smashed, shops entered and cash stolen. As a result of police enquiries and an eagle-eyed neighbourhood officer, a 47-year-old male was arrested and charged with three of the shop burglaries, and bailed for others.
