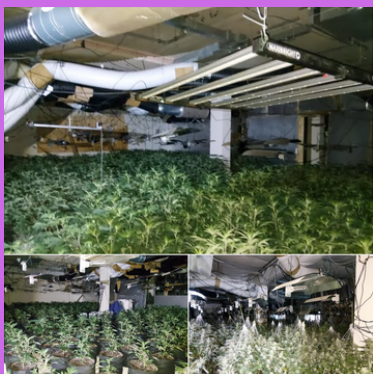

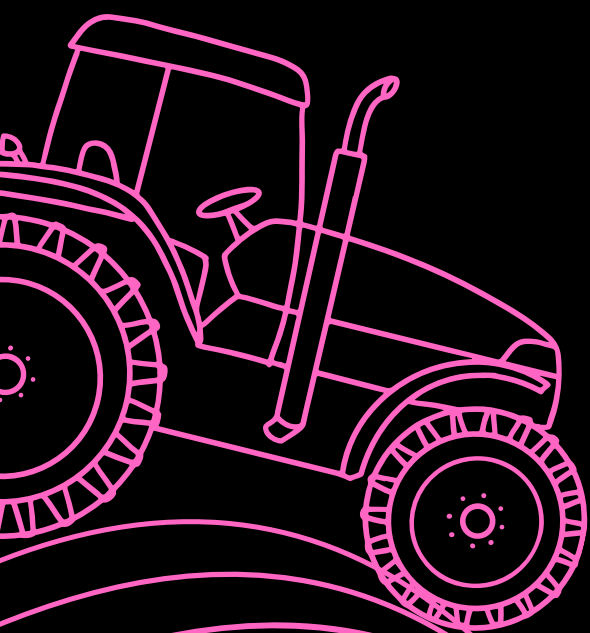

We kicked off the year with a weekend of action, as Surrey officers joined forces with Sussex Police, Hampshire Constabulary and Thames Valley Police to **tackle rural crime**



- **70+** vehicles stopped
- **30+** farms and rural sites visited
- **4** vehicles sized

In just one evening in March, officers tackling county lines drug dealing **arrested 5 people** for drug offences, including intent to supply **class A**

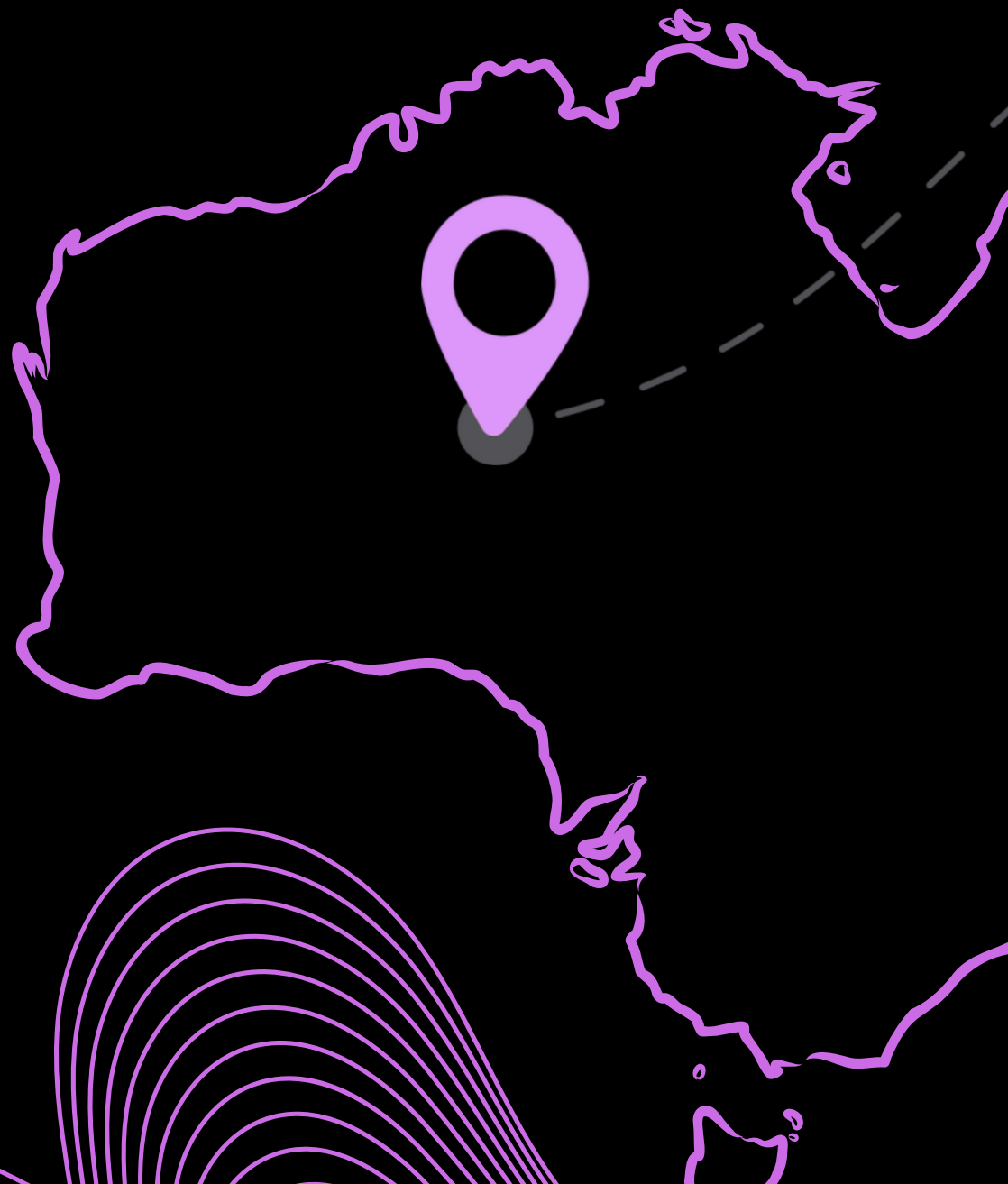


This was only a snapshot of the wider work being done to **keep communities safe**

This year we welcomed **164 new officers** – that's 328 shiny new boots out keeping Surrey safe

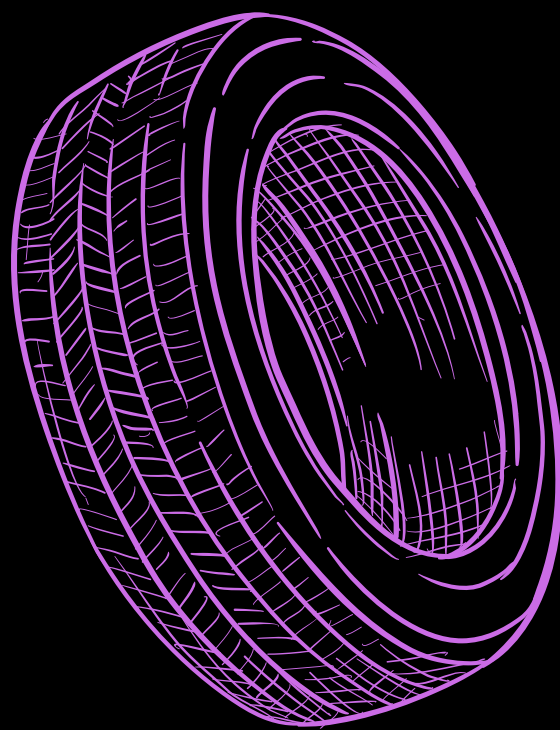
September was our busiest month for welcoming recruits with **48 new officers**
