Community Engagement / Action :

Mile End SNT Officers conducted the checks of illegally claimed garages in partnership with East End Homes at LOWESWATER House, E14. SNT Officers entered several garages while conducting their search and managed to recover a stolen bike.

Police Officers from **MILE END SNT** made several arrests across Mile End Ward including BURDETT ROAD, COPENHAGEN PLACE, RHODESWELL ROAD, PIXLEY STREET and SARACEN STREET. Police Officers were also conducting numerous stop and searches across the ward and issuing several Community Resolutions for the possession of class B drugs.

We did : Mile End SNT officers were conducting regular and visible school patrols and actively checking on children’s welfare as well as making efforts to keep the area as safe as possible for everyone. SNT Officers also provided visible foot and car patrols around RUSSELL House, SARACEN ST, E14 and at TOWER HAMLETS CEMETERY PARK, E3 as our local residents were concerned about anti-social behaviors taking place in these neighbourhood areas.



Mile End SNT Officers were supporting local businesses at COMMERCIAL ROAD, E14 due to number of anti-social behaviors having a negative impact on our local community and business owners. SNT Officers were also issuing ASB Warnings and Community Protection Warnings for people approaching cars stopping at the traffic lights and begging on the junction of BURDETT RD and COMMERCIAL ROAD, E14 MILE END
