- Speeding (10 votes on Neighbourhood Link (NHL)).

 are told drug dealing is an issue. We collect intelligence from residents and CrimeStoppers
 and apply for magistrates warrants and conduct drugs raids on those we suspect of dealing
 in drugs. We encourage anyone to report drug dealing to us anonymously through
 CrimeStoppers.

Some residents of Market Harborough may have seen this White Range Rover failing to stop for officers the other day. The driver of the vehicle decided to drive dangerously through the town and a short time later, due to his severe lack of driving ability, came off the road near to Marston Trussell. The Neighbour Priority Team conducted a search of the area with help from Northants officers, Police Dog (PD) Bryn and the local farming community who kindly provided us with sightings of the males, who had exited the vehicle. A quantity of drugs, phones and other items were located inside the vehicle and nearby which was tracked by the excellent PD Bryn. Both males were soon arrested for failing to stop, driving whilst disqualified, dangerous driving, no insurance and possession with intent to supply class A drugs. Both males were been bailed for further enquiries.



In this month PS Jelbert and PC Glover hosted the Harborough Scouts Group (Harborough District Scouts) for a visit to the police station. The cubs were given a tour of the police station and checked out all the equipment and areas we have in the police station. They also got to sit in the back of our van and even had some fun throwing bean bags at each other with the shields.
