What we've been doing this month:

First of all, I would like to welcome our new Sergeant to the ward, PS Mike Daly. He has joined us in the last month and is looking forward to meeting the community!

Officers carried out several successful warrants this month. These included partnership work with Immigration Enforcement that led to the arrest of a wanted person for immigration offences. A Section 23 Misuse of Drugs Act warrant was executed in Staveley Close, and a Dangerous Dogs Act warrant resulted in a dog being safely seized.

Operational activity also delivered strong results. A traffic operation on the Southwark/Lewisham border led to a vehicle being seized for no insurance and no driving licence, along with two arrests for kidnapping. Two stop and searches under Section 23 of the Misuse of Drugs Act resulted in cannabis seizures and Community Resolutions. Officers also made several arrests, including individuals wanted by police, the courts, or for failing to comply with court orders.

During County Lines Intensification Week, officers focused on safeguarding vulnerable residents. Welfare checks were carried out, a cuckooing referral was made, and multiple referrals were submitted to Project ADDER (Addiction, Diversion, Disruption, Enforcement and Recovery). Officers were also redeployed to support emergency response teams and completed security patrols at the Iranian Embassy over two weekends.

Courts delivered positive outcomes following recent work by officers. A man responsible for ongoing anti-social behaviour on Meeting House Lane was found guilty of breaching his Community Protection Notice and fined £268. Two prolific shoplifters also pleaded guilty; one was remanded in custody for 10 weeks, and the other received a nationwide ban from all Sainsbury's and Tesco stores.

Officers continue to work with partner agencies to reduce ASB on the ward.
