What matters to you

Priority 1: Burglaries.

You said: That you were concerned that your neighbourhood is prone to Burglaries.

We did: The team have been out and about on the beat posting leaflets about crime prevention, to educate on how to keep your home and valuables safe now darker nights are drawing in. We will continue to conduct high visible patrols and maintain a strong policing presence in the community, we will also be holding beat engagements for crime prevention tips.

Priority 2: Anti social behaviour.

You said: That you have experienced anti social behaviour in the area of Allendale Road, In the alleyway between the Barbers and the Vape shop.

We did: We have been increasing patrols of Allendale Road, we have spoken with a few residents, who have complained about males acting inappropriately in the alley of an evening, we have advised them to move on as this was upsetting the local residents.

Priority 3: Anti social behaviour

You said: That E-scooters and E-Bikes are a problem

We did: The team have continued to conduct patrols in these areas to deter issues and try and identify suspects, officers spoke with several riders and educated them about the speeds of an E-bike and the illegal use of E-scooters.

We as a team held engagements at a number of locations in Knighton. We try to vary the days/times and locations giving an even spread over the area hopefully giving residents the opportunity to speak to us about any local issues.
