## What matters to you:

### You Said

- **Antisocial Behaviour** — Residents reported persistent ASB in key locations, particularly during evenings and weekends.
- **Illegal Vehicles** — Concerns were raised about off-road bikes, e-scooters and other illegal vehicles being used on public roads.
- **Speeding** — Multiple streets were highlighted as hotspots for dangerous or inconsiderate driving.

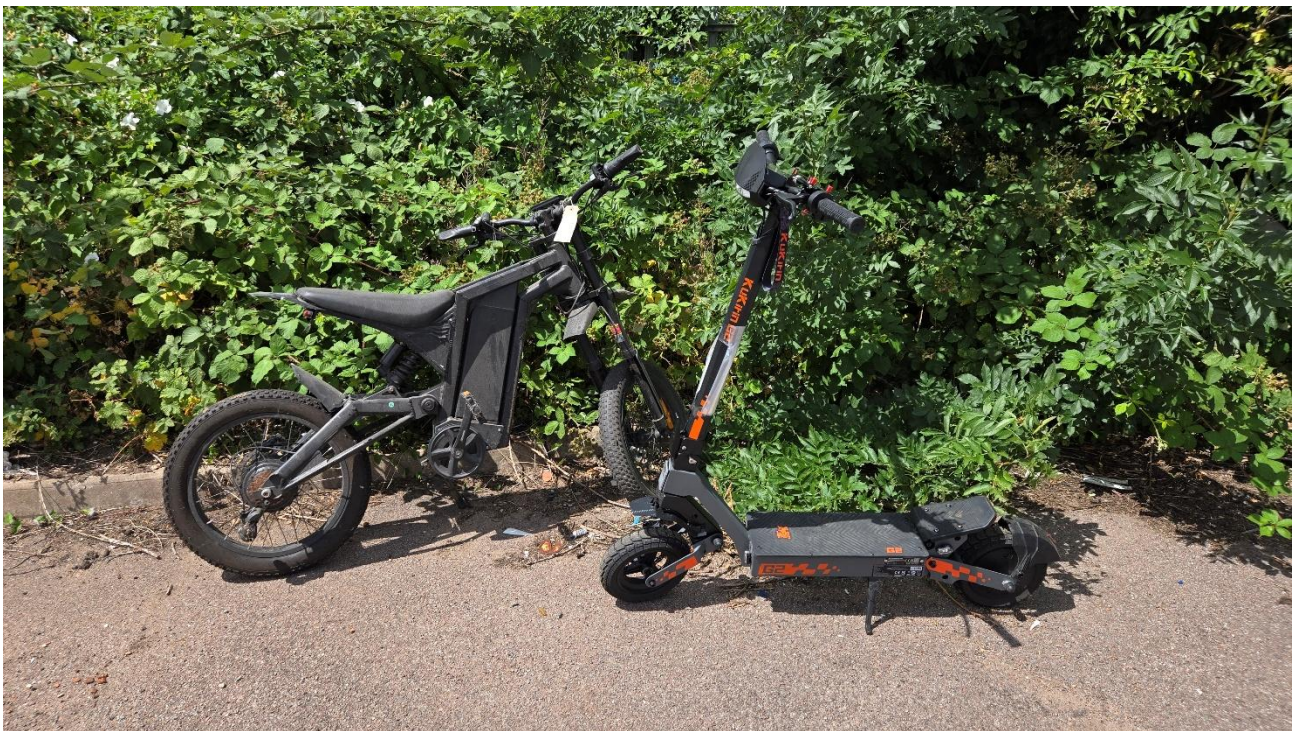
## What we have done #yousaidwedid

### We Did

- **Speed Checks** — Officers conducted targeted speed checks in the areas identified by residents, engaging with drivers and taking enforcement action where necessary.
- **Focused Patrols** — We increased uniformed and plain-clothes patrols in locations with high reports of ASB and illegal vehicle use, resulting in several positive interventions.
- **Vehicle Seizures** — Multiple illegal vehicles were seized; the majority will be destroyed due to their unlawful use and lack of compliance with basic documentation requirements.
- **Vehicle Stops** — Officers have carried out numerous vehicle stops, speaking with drivers, checking documentation and addressing road-safety concerns.
- **Section 59 Notices** — Several drivers received Section 59 warnings for careless or inconsiderate driving, particularly those using off-road bikes or modified vehicles inappropriately.



- **Community Resolutions** — Young offenders involved in ASB were issued Community Resolutions, ensuring accountability while supporting diversion away from further offending.
- **Op Pedalfast** — We ran Op Pedalfast operations targeting illegal riders and unsafe vehicles, resulting in enforcement and intelligence gathering.
- **Fatal 4 Operations** — Dedicated Fatal 4 patrols focused on the four main causes of serious collisions: speeding, drink/drug driving, mobile phone use and not wearing seatbelts.
- **Ongoing Policing Duties** — Alongside these targeted actions, we continued our daily work investigating crime, safeguarding vulnerable people and supporting victims across South Wigston.
