- Speeding.

What have we done

- Speeding checks between 01/08/2024 and 31/08/2024.
 - Five visits to A47, one visit to the A6003 Great Easton and seven visits to B6047 specifically along the core bike route.
- Identifying and targeting the individuals causing the anti social behaviour. Passing their names to the council to start the incremental approach.
- Increasing patrols in areas where anti social behaviour is being reported to us.
