Your priorities are chosen quarterly and are based upon information gathered through NHL (Neighbourhood Link), social media, local engagement, and emerging crime trends. You have stated that the following key themes are important to you. #YouSaidWeDid

You Said	We did
Burglary has been raised as a priority by residents. This will primarily be residential but there are a number of commercial premises on the NH19 area as well.	2 males have been arrested in relation to a number of burglaries. At the time of writing, both males are being interviewed having been located in a stolen vehicle from a burglary in Braunstone Town.
General anti-social behaviour has been raised as a priority by local residents. This includes nuisance by youths at the Meridian Leisure Park	Braunstone Town Council advised the beat team of some youths causing a nuisance at the Civic Centre. We have managed to obtain CCTV footage and all 6 youths have now been identified. Officers have increased patrols in the area.
Road Safety including off road motorbikes, speeding and other general road safety issues raised as a priority by Neighbourhood Link	Speeding data has now been received from the local Council. A speeding operation has now been planned for later this week.

News

The owners of a stolen vehicle successfully located it within hours of its disappearance. The vehicle had been taken from the Aylestone area during the early hours of the morning. Police were informed of the theft at approximately 05:00 hours. Following this, the owners undertook their own search of the surrounding area. At approximately 08:00 hours, the vehicle was located on Colbert Drive, Braunstone Town. The vehicle was subsequently forensically recovered.



We've received reports of ongoing anti-social behaviour in the Kingsway area, involving groups of youths causing nuisance in the local community. This behaviour included incidents such as climbing on roofs, refusing to leave premises when asked and other unruly behaviour. We have now identified the youths and recently paid visits to them and their parents. ASB Warnings have been issued with one youth earning an Acceptable Behaviour Contract as this is now the third time they've been involved in ASB.

We attended another event recently, the annual 360 Play Summer Fayre. PCSO Duane took a table full of road safety items to give away to parents, the highlight being the 'Tales of the Road' booklet which is a fantastic resource to help kids learn to stay safe on the roads. And finally, Officers assisted the Enderby Beat with some Herding. Some cows took a long walk somewhere they shouldn't, but thankfully remained relatively contained with lots of members of the public helping to be a barrier preventing their access to a main road.
