## What we are doing

To tackle anti-social behaviour a local operation has commenced. Officers will be carrying out high visibility patrols around key locations. The team are working with local councillors and other partners to manage any problem tenants associated. Patch walk across the area have recently been conducted with further planned over the coming months.

The team are working to address these concerns and build an intelligence picture to aid enforcement on drug dealing and drug taking. Some enforcement has been carried out. Those suspected have been arrested and we are working with the landlords to secure evictions. Officers have been conducting regular patrols, taking positive action in prosecuting offenders and looking to reduce drug use and dealing in the area. A number of large cannabis factories have been dismantled and investigations are on-going to bring those responsible to justice.

A number of traffic operations are being conducted in the area. The beat team have been out and about, acting in your area, dealing robustly with those speeding and committing driving offences, in an effort to improve road safety. This will continue. Recent speed operations have been successful with large numbers of drivers being prosecuted for driving offences. Beat officers will be providing patrols at local schools at key times to improve the safety of pupils, parents and road users.

# Keep your property safe this summer



Anyone in possession of a zombie-style knife or machete is being encouraged to surrender it under a new Home Office scheme, before these weapons are added to the list of prohibited offensive weapons.



Once the amendment to the Criminal Justice Act 1988 comes into force from 00:00hrs on 24 September 2024, it will be an offence to possess weapons which meet the specified criteria, in a move which aims to reduce the accessibility of some of the deadliest types of knives.



If you have a weapon which meets the criteria, you can surrender it at your nearest designated police station under the scheme which opens at 00:00hrs 26 August 2024 and runs until 23.59hrs 23 September 2024. Compensation will be paid by the Home Office if the weapons being surrendered meet the criteria.
