The man has been charged with offences under the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 and has been reported to the Procurator Fiscal.

## Local News and Updates

A vehicle parked near Ben Lawers was broken into on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and items stolen from within. This is being investigated as a theft.

A vehicle parked in Commercial Street, Blairgowrie was damaged and had a window broken whilst parked up on 28<sup>th</sup> March 2025. The matter is under investigation as a vandalism.

An address in Duchlage Road, Crieff, sustained damage to the front door on 21st March 2025. This is considered a vandalism and is being investigated.

A retail premises in Crieff had graffiti sprayed on its shutters around the 19th of March 2025. The incident is being investigated

A 23 year old male has been reported to the Procurator Fiscal after he was found to be under the influence of cocaine after a road traffic collision in Cargill during February 2025.

A vehicle parked near Inchture on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2025 was found to be damaged in that the roof was scratched. This is being investigated and treated as a vandalism.

A property in Sauchie Terrace, Crieff, had the kitchen window smashed in the early hours of 3rd April 2025. The matter is currently being investigated.

A 22 year old male will be reported to the Procurator Fiscal after failing to stop at a red light on Dunkeld Road, Perth on 5th April.

A 45 year old female appeared at court after she failed to provide a roadside breath test after she was found to be driving on the A9 on 29th March 2025.
