> METROPOLITAN POLICE

Following our investigation with the Met and Bedfordshire Police, three men have been charged in Penn, High Wycombe, Beaconsfield and Loudwater.

More details are below but thanks to Hillingdon Police and Bedfordshire Police for their support on this joint investigation.

Back in February, two of our Wycombe Police Cadets gave up half a day of their half term break to connection with 10 burglaries in Buckinghamshire. The burglaries were in Aylesbury, Stoke Mandeville, come in and work with the Marlow Neighbourhood team, as part of the Volunteer Police Cadets programme. The Cadets used speed guns, visited the CCTV control room, visited Wycombe police station, patrolled the Wooburn Green & Bourne End areas, completed foot patrol with officers in Marlow, and saw officers removing branches blocking a road reported by a member of the public.

Charged

Hillingdon Police 13 March at 13:29 · 🚱

On Monday 11th March at approximately 2243 hours, officers from West Area BCU in partnership with the Flying Squad and MO7 colleagues identified a stolen vehicle at the scene of a recent burglary. With the help of National Police Air Service (NPAS) the vehicle was traced and officers on the ground attempted to stop the vehicle but a pursuit ensued. Shortly after, the vehicle occupants decamped from the vehicle and made off on foot. 3 males were located nearby and arrested for a number of offences.

Due to the incredible hard work of officers from West Areas Complex Case Unit all 3 males were charged with 45 offences relating to conspiracy to commit burglary and aggravated burglary.

The males have been remanded into custody and are awaiting a court date.
