### February round up

Bromyard Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) are based out of the Police Station in Bromyard and cover a large area from Hope-under Dinmore over to Whitbourne and cover 15 Parish councils.

#### **Bromyard ASB update**

During February, we have received several concerns from the residents in Bromyard about a group of youths being involved in Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) in the town. We want to reassure the community that these concerns are being actively addressed. We can't update about live investigations whilst they are on going but, what we can tell you is we have temporarily had three Police officers and one PCSO join the team to help resolve these issues. You may have seen the new team members out and about, as well as the original team, as a huge number of miles have been clocked up on foot patrol around the town in the areas and times ASB has been reported. We are also working with partner agencies for increased efficiency. We are utilising our Policing Powers and legislation taking a positive approach to the ongoing ASB.

#### **Community Survey Results**

Thank you to the 134 people who took the time to complete the survey we put out inviting residents to participate in our short survey to help understand any concerns you're having in your local areas.

111 of these responses were from resident in Bromyard Town, with ASB being a concern, good news is the majority feel safe in their community.

We asked what your top three priorities would be and the results are in;

- 1 Anti-Social Behaviour
- 2 Jointly, Anti-Social Driving and Criminal Damage
- 3 Drugs

We will be working on these priorities and will provide updates when we can.

#### **Good News**

So far in March, we have seen a de-crease in reports of Anti-Social Behaviour in Bromyard Town, This is positive news and we will be continuing our work to address this issue.

In October last year, a small terrier dog was attacked by a larger dog outside the Post Office on Church Street in Bromyard. This incident has now been brought to a close. The little dog was visited this week and was given lots of fusses and has no lasting effects from the attack.

Last week you may have noticed a larger Police presence in Bromyard than usual. This was to locate a male who was outstanding for a number of offences. The male was located and arrested. Due to the ongoing investigations, we can't share anymore information, we will when we can.

### **What else we have been doing**

This month has been business as usual for the rest of patch. Earlier this month we attended Brockhampton Nursery to tell the children all about the Police, let them know that we are here to help and show them around are Police Truck.

We attended a careers event at the Queen Elizabeth High School to answer questions from anyone thinking of joining the Police.

We were at Edwyn Ralph Village Hall for our Monthly Coffee with a Cop. We also attended the Kempson Playing Fields Association meeting as well as the Hereford Against Nighttime Disorder (HAND) meeting with the local Pub Landlords. We attended Stoke Lacy and Ocyle Pychard Parish Council Meetings, and our inspector attended Bromyard Town council meeting to address the concerns around the ongoing ASB.

We have also taken the engagement van for Surgeries to be accessible as possible to the public, we held surgeries in Whitbourne, Pencombe and at the Co-Op in Bromyard.
