

Brunswick and Adelaide PCSO Monthly Update

Hello, everyone!

This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.



Within the month of May:

- Reports of ASB increased to 44 reports.
- There were no reports of burglaries.
- There were 6 reports of criminal damage.



Patrols:

There were 13 patrols within the month of May. The average patrol time was 32 minutes. Due to increased demand from scene guards, house-to-house enquiries, and operations in the greater Brighton and Hove area, we haven't been able to be on foot as much, but hopefully, this will change in the coming weeks.

Specifics:

- 1 report of drug use in Palmeira Square.
- 1 report of a stolen blue badge.
- 2 motorbikes stolen from Brunswick Road and Lansdowne Road respectively.
- 3 e-bikes stolen from Second Avenue.
- 1 vehicle stopped and search for drugs check resulting in an arrest.



Key Priorities:

- To increase visibility in the Hove Lawns area as the weather warms up and engage in extra patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
