What matters to you

Our beat priorities reflect what you have mentioned and highlighted to us will remain as the previous month April 2025

- **Priority 1: Vehicle related ASB—Howard Road** – Through reports and community consultations with residents and Leicester City Council. We have identified ASB hotspots on the Neighbourhood beat area.

What we did: We continue to engage and listen to residents in relation to vehicles causing noise and groups gathering. We will be continuing work with our partners, Leicester City Council, WQE College Staff to help lower ASB in the area.

- **Priority 2: e-Scooters and e-Bikes** - Ongoing concerns of e-scooters and e-bikes being ridden inappropriately and recklessly in the Clarendon Park Area.

What we did: e-bikes and e-scooters have been seized by your local police officers on Queens Road and Welford Rd this was also highlighted on our social media, this action will continue.

- **Priority 3: Victoria Park - Seasonal issues:** Victoria Park is becoming much busier especially with warmer weather approaching, this normally brings out communities to make good use of open park facilities.

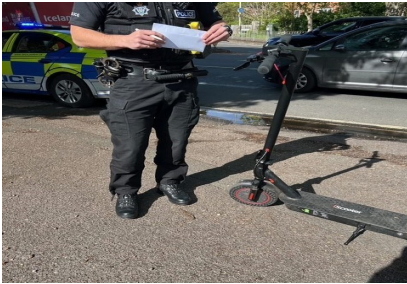
What we Did: We will continue to patrol and work with Leicester City council parks team, to ensure it is a safe environment and especially when we have organised events are being hosted on the park.

Other Local News

- **Hartopp Rd/Howard Rd** - Officers have issued Section 59 warnings to drivers using vehicles in an anti-social manner, causing Harassment, Alarm and Distress.
- **Victoria Park**- Officer's have conducted visible foot patrols on Victoria park, also monitoring the car park for speeding vehicles.

Engagements/community consultations: Neighbourhood officers have conducted regular beat surgeries and community engagements with face to face meeting urging our members of the local community to come and raise their concerns.

- **Queens Road/Welford Rd**- in relation to E-Scooters/E-Bikes, officers have conducted number of stops and seized illegal/modified bikes.
