Anti -Social behaviour with motorbikes:

The team is aware of the increasing number of motorbikes contributing to anti-social behaviour in the area. We are actively working to address this issue by gathering intelligence from local residents who have been affected. If you have any information—such as locations, photographs, details of where the bikes may be stored, or identities of those involved—please report it. Youths causing Anti social behaviour:

The team have experienced many issues with the local youths in the area causing Anti social behaviour. The forces policy is to use the incremental approach when dealing with youths. We as a team have taken the most appropriate steps to ensure that parents are aware of what their children have been doing and to robustly inform them of the consequences of their action by issuing warning letters.

Tackling drug dealing and shop thefts:

The team have been doing significant work alongside partnering agencies, on cracking down on offences including drug dealing and shop thefts. The result of these were, arrest attempts being made by the PC's of the beat and conducting further investigations on these offences.

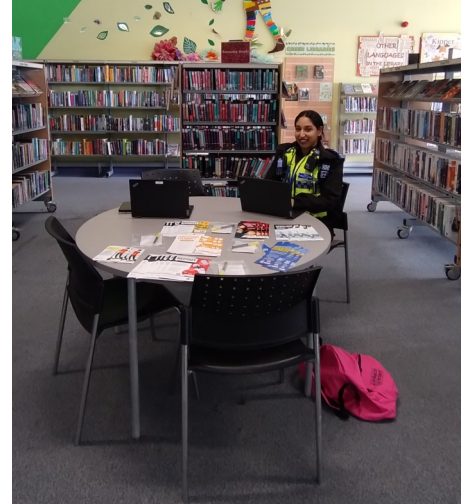


• Other Operations:

- Operation Diwali:

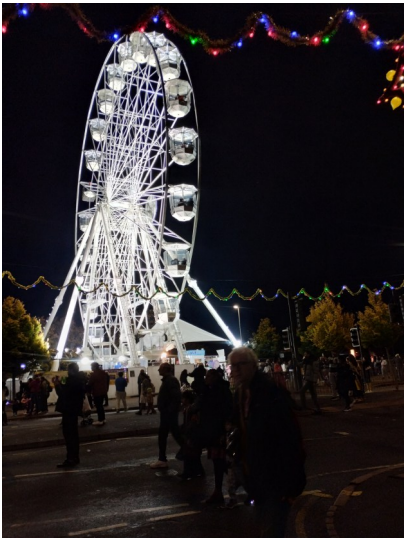
