#WeDid - What We have Done

Priority 1: Agar Nook & Greenhill Beat Newsletter

Officers and PCSOs have continued regular patrols throughout Agar Nook and Greenhill in response to concerns regarding anti-social behaviour (ASB), off-road motorcycles, and criminality linked to local hotspot locations. During the reported period, numerous high-visibility patrols were conducted across Agar Nook, Greenhill, Twyford Close, Stretton Drive, Stamford Drive and surrounding areas, the patrols will continue.

Priority 2: HGVs Ellistown and Ibstock

Regular high-visibility patrols have been carried out throughout the area, with the majority of patrols reporting no significant issues or incidents. Officers continue to visit identified hotspot locations to provide reassurance to residents and deter anti-social behaviour.

In Ellistown, officers completed a visit to a local male following reports of vehicle-related anti-social behaviour. Words of advice were provided, and a Section 59 warning remains in place.

Priority 3: Speeding

Officers conducted targeted patrols in the area where speeding concerns had been raised by residents. High-visibility patrols were carried out at key times to monitor vehicle speeds, provide reassurance to the community and deter unsafe driving.
